Along the Strada Volterrana that goes from Castelfiorentino to Gambassi, not far from the sources of *salsa* water, whose healing virtues have been known since ancient times, the church of San Martino appears to be modern, but its structure could at least partly hide a Medieval framework.

Historical sources name it for the first time in 1275, but it is certain that the place where it stands was already documented in the 12th Century.
